

Who will onboard the Swedish system (SMVS)?

Do these instructions concern you and your company?

Who	How	Article in the Delegated Regulation (2016/161)/paragraph in Läkemedelsverkets vägledning (the MPA guidance)
Pharmacy chain	Onboarding by the head office, which creates credentials to every single pharmacy in the chain	Article 25.1
Pharmacy	Onboarding by independent pharmacies.	Article 25.1
Hospital pharmacy	The healthcare provider, or the company which by an agreement is assigned to act as the Hospital Pharmacy function, will have to onboard.	Article 25.1 or Article 25.2 Paragraph 2.2
Wholesaler	Onboard if you have a Wholesale Distribution Authorisation and is responsible for physical handling of products and/or if you by agreement with a healthcare provider is given the assignment to decommission on their behalf.	Article 20-24 Paragraph 2.2
Third party logistics (3PL)	Onboard if you have an agreement with MAH or Wholesaler which covers assignment to verify and/or decommission packages	Article 20-24
MAH	In most cases onboarding to SMVS is not necessary since safety features are uploaded through the European Hub. If you have a Wholesaler Distribution Authorisation and are physically handling products for distribution you may need to onboard to SMVS to be able to perform obligations as a wholesaler in SMVS	Article 33
Vaccination agencies	Onboard if decommissioning are done by yourselves. If you have an	Article 25.2 Paragraph 2.2 och 2.3

	agreement with your supplier about decommissioning the supplier needs to be onboarded.	
Health Clinics Private healthcare providers Outpatient healthcare	Onboard if decommissioning are done by yourselves. If you have an agreement with your supplier about decommissioning, the supplier needs to be onboarded.	Paragraph 2.2
Prisons, Dental care, Nursing home, School health service	Onboard if decommissioning are done by yourselves. If you have an agreement with your supplier about decommissioning the supplier needs to be onboarded.	Paragraph 2.2
