Organisation	Do you need to onboard the Swedish Medical Verification System (SMVS)?	Reference in the European Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2016/161
Pharmacy chain	Onboarding required. Pharmacy chain head office responsible for onboarding of every single pharmacy in the chain.	Article 25
Pharmacy (independent)	Onboarding required	Article 25
Extempore pharmacy	Onboarding required if approved pharmaceuticals used in extempore manufacturing.	Article 25

Organisation	Do you need to onboard the Swedish Medical Verification System (SMVS)?	Reference in the European Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2016/161
Hospital pharmacy	Onboarding required The healthcare provider, or the company which by an agreement is assigned to act as the Hospital Pharmacy function, is responsible for onboarding.	Article 23, 25 and 26
Vaccination agencies	Onboarding required if decommissioning is done by yourselves. If decommissioning takes place according to assignment agreement the supplier needs to be onboarded.	Article 23, 25 and 26
Health Clinics, Private healthcare providers, Outpatient healthcare	Onboarding required if decommissioning is done by yourselves. If decommissioning takes place according to assignment agreement the supplier needs to be onboarded.	Article 23, 25 and 26
Prisons, Nursing home,	Onboarding required if decommissioning is done by yourselves.	Article 23, 25 and 26

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Dental care, School health service	If decommissioning takes place according to assignment agreement the supplier needs to be onboarded.

Holder of Wholesale Distribution Authorisation (WDA)		
Organisation	Do you need to onboard the Swedish Medical Verification System (SMVS)?	Reference in the European Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2016/161
Wholesaler	Onboarding required if the wholesaler is responsible for physical handling of products which includes verification and decommissioning of packages.	Article 20-24
Third party logistics (3PL)	Onboard if you have an agreement with MAH or Wholesaler which covers assignment to verify and/or decommission packages.	Article 20-24

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Organisation	Do you need to onboard the Swedish Medical Verification System (SMVS)?	Reference in the European Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2016/161
Wholesaler not handling physical packages	Onboarding not required if packages not handled by the holder of Wholesale Distribution Authorisation.	n/a
MAH/Manufacturer	<p>No technical onboarding to SMVS for MAH/Manufacturer. Connection and uploading of safety features are done to the European hub.</p> <p>If the company holds a Wholesale Distribution Authorisation and are physically handling products which includes verification and decommissioning, see "Wholesaler".</p>	Article 33
